The night of PESACH

This Feast is celebrated on the 14th of Nisan. Since the Hebrew people are using Lunar calendar and we are using Solar calendar, the exact time of this Feasts changes between March and April.

Feast: Pesach | Passover

Date: Nisan 14th


Scripture reference: Lev 23:5

Revelation of Messiah: Sacrificed Lamb

Lamb of G-D

Prophetic sign: G-D's provision for man's

salvation.



Passover was clearly instituted before the tenth plague that hit the Egyptians before the Israelites were allowed to leave Egypt. GOD instructed Moses and Aaron in Exodus 12:1-13 to sacrifice an unblemished male lamb, a year old (v. 5) and to kill it at twilight (v.6). Take note that the reckoning of day among the Hebrew people starts at the sundown of the day before. Part of the directive was to take some blood and put it in the door post and on the lintel of the house (v.7). They shall eat the lamb meat roasted, with unleavened bread and bitter herbs (v.8).

Fast forwarding around 1,500 years after was the last Passover meal Yeshua had with His disciples before He was crucified as recorded in Mark 14:12 and Luke 22:1. Yeshua was killed the next day, which was the day of the Passover. While there were a lot of Passover lambs that are being sacrificed for the people, there is one Passover lamb that is being sacrificed at around 3:00 pm in the Temple as a representative Passover lamb for the people. This practice was developed over time and was practiced during the first century. It is so amazing that this practice was a shadow of what will happen afterwards as Yeshua died at exactly the 9th hour or (3:00 pm) (Mark 15:34-37; Luke 23:44-46). Yeshua fulfilled His tasks as a Passover Lamb on the exact day of the Passover Feast and died at the exact hour that the Passover lamb was being killed.
